HUD CoC Competition

- Over \$2.2 billion in funding to all CoCs

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- MI BoS CoC - One Collaborative Applicant for 59 counties

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- BoS CoC is soliciting 1-year projects that are renewed annually

APPLICATION PROCESS



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Local Process



- Local application submitted to BoS CoC
- Includes narrative responses, attachments, and verification of eligibility
- Scored then ranked for funding



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HUD Process



- Application completed in eSNAPS (Special Needs Assistance Programs)
- Includes narrative responses, attachments, and verification of eligibility
- Funded according to local ranking (unless HUD deems otherwise)



RANKING APPLICATIONS



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Ranking completed in "Tiers"



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Tier 1 (\$8,474,706):

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Tier 2:

- Remaining amount of all available funds
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- Least secure - based on overall CoC competitiveness



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Tier 2:

- Remaining amount of all available funds
- Bonus funding amounts
- Least secure - based on overall CoC competitiveness

To be considered for ranking, New and Bonus projects must meet the local application scoring threshold



NEW & BONUS AMOUNTS



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- Based on HUD's calculations
- Formulas outlined in the NOFA
- Actual for Bonus funding amounts found in the CoC Estimated Annual Renewal Demand report

New Project Funding

- \$846,648 in reallocated funding from Renewal Projects (estimate)



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CoC Bonus Project Funding

- \$450,782
- Not DV-specific



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- Not DV-specific

DV Bonus Project Funding

- \$655,991
- Must target and serve DV population but applicant and potential subrecipients do not have to be DV services providers



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HMIS



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HMIS

**Eligible DV Bonus Project*



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- Led by household choice



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Supportive Services Only - Coordinated Entry

- Coordinated Entry is not just the HARA (though historically the subrecipient)
- Demonstrate ability to function as a system
