 - b. Review of Coordinated Entry Policy- Update: Jesica will resend the link.
 - c. Increasing Coverage in Upper Peninsula and Northern Michigan:
 - i. Rayme can survey her liaisons across the UP- will be helpful in the younger populations- Menominee, Sault Ste Marie, Escanaba, Marquette have the highest numbers. Struggling to identify providers, not finding agencies with capacity, LSS and CFS are potential partners. Focus on under 18 first, then explore more supports for 18-24.
 - d. Youth Survey: UP Pilot- Rayme could send out any links to liaisons although the pandemic is likely to reduce the input. Experience in NE has been difficult, but they are working with Boys and Girls Club and MKV to gather participants for their needs assessment. Has referenced the Teen Café format with table topics.
 - e. Youth Listening Session in Montcalm, Ionia, Gratiot, Isabella Counties
 - i. Partnership with Membership & Nominating Committee
 - ii. Facilitator from NM YHDP project: Would be great to have the facilitator come to this committee to learn more about her process.
 - iii. How do we get with the youth to participate? Will the HARA be able to? Might need more help. MKV have the youth—these will be key partnerships.
 - iv. Finding more need for services in Midland area,
 - v. Inviting the facilitator, include Tina as coordinator on this.
