

END HOMELESSNESS FOR YOUTH

Join the Youth Advisory Board!

What it is: The Michigan Balance of State Continuum of Care (MIBOSCOC) is a group working to end homelessness across 61 rural Michigan counties. The Youth Advisory Board (YAB) focuses specifically on preventing and ending homelessness for people under age 25. Visit www.miboscoc.com to learn more.

Requirements: First, be at least 16 but not more than 24 years old at the time of application. You must also have experienced homelessness in or be a resident of (now or previously) one of the counties outlined in the [logo/ map](#) below. Compensation: The YAB typically meets weekly or four times per month. YAB members are compensated for their time and expertise at a rate of \$50 per hour. Payments are issued monthly and are currently available via Paypal, Zelle or paper check.
